Call for Submission of Manuscripts

Submission of manuscripts from both academicians and practitioners of all areas of Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Chemical Sciences, Mathematical Sciences, Mathematics and Statistics, Engineering Sciences, Earth Science etc are invited. Submitted manuscripts (strictly as per suggested template) should not have been previously published or currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. Conference papers may also be submitted if the paper has been completely re-written (variation of minimum 30% including new title). Papers unpublished but presented in any of Assam Science Society's annual technical sessions held during the last few years are also open for submission. All the articles shall go through plagiarism check and a double peer review process.

Submission guidelines-

Maximum length- 10 pages as per suggested template. Art work figure work- JPEG format, 200 to 300 dpi resolution; Mathematical formulae- Microsoft equation editor should be used. Last date of submission- 10 November, 2021. Acceptance notification- 10 December, 2021. Manuscripts not as per suggested template shall not be reviewed and will be returned back.
